

NEW GIRLS GOING WILD

Latest netball squad finally revealed after talent-spotting trials

THE team chosen to play for the Glasgow Wildcats this season has been revealed.

A total of 15 players have been selected for the Wildcats squad following trials in October.

The squad includes three new faces joining an existing 12 from last season's line-up.

This year's team showcases some of the strongest netball talent from across Scotland, with 11 of the Wildcats also playing in the Scottish National Squad which flew out for the Six Nations Cup in Singapore last week.

The players will make their first official appearance against Leeds Carnegie in Leeds on December 19 in their first competitive match of the season in The Co-Operative Netball Superleague – the leading domestic league.

The squad were introduced at the first in a series of schools netball festivals scheduled to take place this winter, which ran last week.

Held in the Kelvin Hall, the development sessions have been designed to

give all upper primary school children in Glasgow the chance to try netball.

The session saw more than 150 boys and girls benefit from coaching tips and advice from the Wildcats, before taking part in a series of five-a-side mini-games and moves.

Denise Holland, Head Coach of the Glasgow Wildcats, said she hoped the squad would act as role models to budding young players.

She added: "The Glasgow Wildcats are role models in their chosen sport; they demonstrate the qualities needed to perform at the highest level.

"I am delighted at the way in which our entire performance team operates, with passion, vision and complete commitment to the sport at all levels of the game."

The Wildcats will play their home games at Kelvin Hall International Sports Arena and at Bellahouston Leisure Centre.

Thousands of fans are expected to watch their matches live and televised on Sky Sports.
